



PNTA TWO DAY TRIAL RESULTS – MAY 10/11, 2014 **Sponsored by the Victoria Motorcycle Club**

The Victoria Motorcycle Club hosted rounds three and four of the Pacific Northwest Trials Association (PNTA) series on the May 10/11 weekend at the club's property on Happy Valley Road. Thirty two competitors each day challenged themselves with dry conditions under sunny skies. Ten separate sections were laid out by Don Venn each day with varying degrees of difficulty for the seven classes of riders from novice to champion.

Young Nik Ferguson on his Gas Gas came away with a pair of wins in the Novice class while Liam Buss also on a Gas Gas entered and won his first ever trial in the Intermediate class on Saturday so he came back and did it again on Sunday! Corey Venn took second place on Saturday but did not ride on Sunday. Second place on Sunday went to Steven Dardengo while Ben Cox took third on both days. All were on Gas Gas.

In the Senior Intermediate class on Saturday, it was a battle between Don Venn and Ernie Ferguson with Venn coming out on top with 8 points and nineteen cleans and Ferguson with 9 points and 22 cleans. Kevin Couves took third spot with 20 points and 21 cleans. Sunday was a different story as Venn and Ferguson did not ride. Kevin took top spot with 24 points and 19 cleans. Second and third went to Mark Palmer, 48 points and 8 cleans, and Hank Wirth, 61 points and 4 cleans. All were Gas Gas mounted.

In the Advanced class, Paul Lederis took first place but could only manage a third spot on Sunday. Neil Cottier was second on Saturday but did not ride on Sunday. Third place Saturday went to Jeremy McChesney who pulled up his socks on Sunday and took first place. Second place on Sunday went to Brandon Volk. All were Gas Gas mounted.

Dave Nunn on his Gas Gas ran away with first place on both days in the Senior Advanced class while Gary Lawver also on Gas Gas took second place on both days. It was the same for third spot on both days as Ron Ringette rode his Montesa to a podium finish.

Andrew Watson on his Gas Gas and former Canadian Trials Champion Steve Fracy on a Beta finished first and second respectively both days in the Expert class. Saturday's third place went to Sherco mounted Stan Bakaard from Yale. On Sunday Stan slipped to fourth place as John Webster on a Gas Gas took third place.

In the Champion class, last years Canadian National Trials Champion and newly married Thomas Cordner finished second on Saturday and first on Sunday after good close competition with Daniel Blanc-Gonnet who travelled up from Oregon to be with us as well as Alex Walton visiting from Vancouver. Blanc-Gonnet on a Sherco was first on Saturday and second on Sunday. Walton placed third on both days.
