The Les Blow Twin Shock Trial was run on Valentines Day at the VMC's Club property on Happy Valley Road. Fourteen riders entered using a variety of older twin shock machines - some in pristine condition while others had a few battle scars. Organized by Dave Fair, the event consisted of ten well layed out sections designed to test the fundamental skills of the riders. Good competition and comeraderie between the riders was the order of the day. It was wet and misty as riders slipped and slid around using the Junior/ Intermediate loop of the Les Blow Trial. A fun time was had by all but scorekeeping was a bit "dodgy" as most, but not all, of the competitors switched to the tougher Intermediate lines after one loop. The results are:-
